VE Testing Schedule Change

The schedule for VE Testing has been changes. Since there are other groups offering testing on the first Saturday of the month, testing will be changed to the second Saturday of each month.

Additional Christmas Parade information:

3:00 – 3:30 PM – Meet and receive entrant lists and block assignments and go over staging duties.

4:00 PM – 8th street closed to traffic and staging begins.

5:00 PM – All entrants are to be in place. (*Yeah, I know, I know.*)

6:15 PM – All entrants must be ready. (*Yeah, I know this too!*)

6:30 PM – Parade starts.

The East side of 8th street (the EVEN numbered entrants) go first, followed by the West side of 8th (the ODD numbered entrants).

Main things to watch for: Drivers on cell phones and lack of walkers at all four corners of any entrant with people in the bed of pickups or people on floats.

In case of weather cancelation the parade will be held Tuesday December 3rd. If it is canceled again it will be held Monday December 9th.
