Temple Christmas Parade

The Temple Christmas parade will be held Monday December 7th at 6:30 PM.

Because of COVID-19 major changes have been implemented for this years parade.

Parade entrants will be stationary and the public will travel in their own vehicles along the parade route to safely view the parade entrants.

This necessitated a location change for the parade. Rather than being on Adams Ave, the entrants will be lined up on a route along Avenues A and B through downtown Temple. The route begins at 8th street and Ave A transitioning to Ave B before later transitioning again to Ave A. The route ends at 9th street and Ave A.

TARC is only responsible for three blocks of the parade route. Two blocks of Avenue A from 8th street to 4th street and one block through the Police department parking lot between Ave A and Avenue B.
